


Sword Bible Memory

January 6th



Lesson: The Ascension - Acts 1:1-14

Theme: Jesus will come again!

Family Questions: Where did Jesus go in today's story? (Back to Heaven with the Father.) Read 1 Thess. 4:15-5:9 and discuss Jesus' 2nd coming!

January 13th



Lesson: Pentecost - Acts 2:1-13

Theme: The Holy Spirit came as Jesus promised!

Family Questions: Why were all the disciples gathered? (Waiting for the power Jesus promised.) What happened when the Holy Spirit came? How did people react to hearing their own language? (*surprised!*) What do we learn about God at Pentecost? (Promise Keeper, Power over his creation, God's plans will be accomplished.) The Holy Spirit lives in every believer!

January 20th



Lesson: Peter Explains the Gospel - Acts 2:14-41

Theme: The Gospel has power

Family Questions: What did Peter do in the story? (Shared the Gospel.) What prophet did he quote? (Joel) Who is the Holy Spirit? How many believed that day? (3,000)

January 27th



Lesson: New Believers - Acts 2:42-47

Theme: The Gospel changes hearts

Family Questions: Discuss the word "repent" (to turn and change course.) Why was the early church so joyful? (They believed in Jesus!) What did they do together? Share ways that God has changed you! Share how you might help those around you!
